Due to the current financial situation, it was decided at a recent Governors' Body meeting, that a contribution of £2.00 should be requested from every participating pupil in school sporting activities which involves transport to another venue. Until now the cost of buses to transport pupils to various competitions has been borne by the school. However, with a depleting budget the school no longer has the means to foot the increasing sums needed to cover transport costs. This decision was not made lightly, but it is regrettably the only means by which our pupils will continue to be able to compete at various events. As expressed at the beginning of the letter, I would like to stress that this decision was made by the Governors and was a very difficult decision to make.

The money should be taken directly to the school office and should not be presented to members of the PE department.

I am sure you would agree that pupils derive great benefit from participating in various team activities and tournaments and they have been incredibly successful. The requested sum is a small price to pay to ensure that the pupils can continue to participate in various competitions.
